
Children's Undergram Thermometer



Directions:

- 1. Peel off thermometer from backing and place on the side of the body in the axilla (armpit).
- 2. Close arm and wait 2-3 minutes for the first temperature measurement – shorter times may give inaccurate readings.

How To Read:

- 1. Lift arm to read. Thereafter readings are virtually instant. Just lift the arm to take the next measurement.
- 2. Look at dot grid. The highest black dot indicates the correct temperature (see example).

Note: TraxIt® will adhere to the armpit through bathing and may be left in place up to 48 hours on normal, healthy, intact skin.

To Remove:


Gently peel off and discard. DO NOT REUSE.


- ±.2°F within the critical range of 98.0°F to 102.0°F; ±0.4°F elsewhere.
- ±.1°C within the critical range of 37.0°C to 39.0°C; ±0.2°C elsewhere

No Temperature Offset:

TraxIt $^{\circ}$ displays the actual axillary temperature. Axillary temperature readings are typically 0.5°F (0.3°C) lower than oral and 1.0°F (0.6°C) lower than rectal.
